**“We have always lived in slums and holes in the wall. We will know how to accommodate ourselves for a time.**

**“For, you must not forget, we can also build. It is we the workers who built these palaces and cities here in Spain and in America and everywhere.**

**“We, the workers, can build others to take their place. And better ones! We are not in the least afraid of ruins.**

**“We are going to inherit the earth; there is not the slightest doubt about that.**

**“The bourgeoisie [bosses and politicians] might blast and ruin its own world, before it leaves the stage of history.**

**“We carry a new world here, in our hearts. That world is growing this minute.”**
